



<u>Fusion 360 – Guest Lecture and Workshop</u> <u>Prerequisite Instructions</u>

Free Access to Autodesk Educational Software:

Did you know that educators and your students are given free access to Autodesk software, including Fusion 360. If you don't already have an Autodesk Educational account with access to free software, please consider creating an account and applying for education access at least two weeks prior to the start of your workshop. To do so please follow the instructions below:

Sign up for an Autodesk Education Account <u>here</u>.

- Scroll down until you see Fusion 360 and click GET STARTED and follow the prompts to create your account and get verified as an educational user.
- Watch video titled <u>Create an account and confirm eligibility</u> for instructions on how to setup your account and get verified as an educational user.

Once your account is setup, follow these instructions **if you will be using your own laptop** at the workshop event:

- Download Fusion 360 onto your laptop <u>here</u>.
- Watch video titled **Get products** for instructions on how to download Fusion 360.

Although some workshops do provide lab computers, you'll still need to login to Fusion 360 with your own Autodesk account/Fusion 360 credentials.

You will need to sign up for an Autodesk Education account to participate in the handson portion of the workshop, regardless of which computer you will use.
